Hi, all!

Is there any .sch file macro for CREATEing a column like  
'my\_column\_id' TIMESTAMP NOT NULL DEFAULT CURRENT\_TIMESTAMP'  
in a MySQL DB?

Is it what MySqlSchema.h macro TIMESTAMP(ts) does, i.e. creates a column that defaults to  
CURRENT\_TIMESTAMP?

If so, could anyone give me an example on how to use it?

I've tried  
TIME\_ (MY\_COLUMN\_ID) TIMESTAMP("CURRENT\_TIMESTAMP"),  
it compiled fine, but the resulting CREATE TABLE statement defaults column to NULL.
