```
COLUMN_("TIMESTAMP", Time, MY_COLUMN_ID, 0, 0)
```

The following column results from the code above:

```
MY_COLUMN_ID timestamp NOT NULL DEFAULT CURRENT_TIMESTAMP ON UPDATE  
CURRENT_TIMESTAMP
```

Now, how do I get rid of the 'ON UPDATE CURRENT_TIMESTAMP' part?
