The thing is that for the updater to detect changes, the local source tree must be kept clean. If you add another directories in there, and they are missing in the system-wide sources (in /usr/share/upp), the updater thinks they were removed from U++ and suggest to delete them (quite correctly). I have been lately working on some improvements in the detection which might solve this, at least partialy, but it is not in state to be committed safely just yet.

I think I will also add some sort of "ignore pattern", so you could mark files/directories to be ignored by the update mechanism. That is probably the best universal solution I can think of.
