Reimplementing the entire Draw core was not to my liking, so I actually wrote a new GUI very similar to U++. Some programing style and method names, but not really compatible. But it is very lightweight. It is designed for touchscreens and its conventions. Also, font support is very poor because it does not have TTF. But you can change the back end, using software rendering, OpenGI or DirectX. Only dependencies are Core and Irrlicht.

It is a very early version, but I may be able to compile some reference examples without modifying the logic in the near future.

On modern hardware it can do hundreds of frames/second.

But enough about me.

Any chance of your OpenGL implementation becoming a standard alternative back end?

Yep. But we really need to make CtrlCore more friendly for it...
