Thanks for feedback. koldo wrote on Sun, 29 May 2011 15:17 Perhaps I would do a full file with all inside (Theide, U++ and all packages), and a list of smaller files with packages only used by skilled U++ users. Like "sudo apt-get install upp"? That works now (installing upp + theide) and would work with the proposed changes as well (just installing theide, upp-uppsrc, upp-bazaar, upp-tutorial, upp-examples and upp-reference). From the point of novice user nothing changes.

BTW: The splitting of packages to smaller self-consistent units is quite common (see for example libboost in ubuntu) and also encouraged in the debian packaging manual IIRC...
