Well, it seems that OpenCV C++ API is right that "too cryptic" case. Take, for example, `cv::calibrateCamera` method. I might use `cvCalibrateCamera` (OpenCV C API), but I, personally, find such decisions inconsistent - I use C++ because I want to use it, not because I can use C syntax in it.

By "skipping namespaces" I meant just not typing them. E.g. type just `calibrat` and Assist should show `calibrateCamera`. It works as if there was always appropriate using namespace ... even when there isn't
