You can iterate over all cells:

```
for(int i = 0; i < grid.GetCount(); i++)
    for(int j = 0; j < grid.GetColumnCount(); j++)
    {
        if(grid.IsSelected(i, j))
        {
            ... do anything ...
        }
    }
}
```

for checking rows only or you can use this macro

```
FOREACH_SELECTED_ROW(grid)
{
    PromptOK(Format("Selected row: %d", grid.GetCurrentRow()));
    ... do my code...
}
```

As you noticed you can also retrieve number of selected rows/cells:

```
int selectedRows = grid.GetSelectedCount();
int selectedCells = grid.GetSelectedItemsCount();
```

Quote:

CTRL+LMB or a Shift+LMB selection (they differ by 1)

Thanks. I'll try to fix that.

There are no GetSelectionBegin/End() methods (what should they return if there are multiple selections?)
