This is fine code, but I am afraid too specialised for Core (I guess Core is sort of overloaded now).

What about bazaar or plugin or maybe Geom? Or perhaps Painter?

Maybe we should start a new "high level" raster graphics package? I think the equalization code would fit nicely there.

This code is not quite correct. I have the latest tested version. I used this code to autolevel color images (converted into CIE L\*a\*b\*). HSV autolevel of color images loses some color (this problem persists in Photoshop too).

Ok, I can prepare a package and upload into bazaar. But I think it is a better idea to include it in Painter.
