K\_DELTA is 65536, which > that all unicode characters (well, in theory it is not, but in practice, it is).

The idea is that Key is supposed to manage ALL key events - that includes (unicode) character events and other key events. Thus first 65536 values are reserved for character events and other events, like "K\_UP" or "K\_A" have K\_DELTA (originally, in Win32, K\_DELTA is added to noncharacter keycode).

Maybe we could figure out a better synonym But basically it means "this is not a character".
