Hello,

the application is almost ready. Now I would like to make it international. I've read the document "Internationalization and translation files" but I need some other hint. For the moment I've marked with `t_("...")` the string of the application where I want should appear some other language. I would like to provide several translation files that the user can modify as he likes. Once he set one language each time the application run with the same language. For the moment let's talk only about Italian translation. I guess I must use UTF8 code (I want to support even Russian alphabet).

If I've understood I have to produce a translation file for each language. Unfortunately I've not been able to export a .tr file with `t_(...)` string of my application. I've tried

```
myapp --export-tr itit-
```

but the file obtained didn't contain my `t_(...)` but only those of the U++ library. Where I do mistake?
