One thing I forgot - it doesn't support every wav file. Only the basic uncompressed formats.

It doesn't record any sound though, or at least when I try and play it back I get nothing. Also it does the sound as raw, and not as a wav file. And if I run the record and try and play 2 times I get:

Warning Heap leaks detected.

I'll try to have a look at this. There shouldn't be any leaks. Can you have a look into the recorded "raw" sound saved to file? If there is a problem with the portaudio part, it would be most probably all zero bytes. Does it detect any recording device in the info tab?

I'll also try to pull together some example of recording to wav file. Probably tomorrow, hope you don't hurry too much
