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qwerty wrote on Wed, 24 May 2006 06:04: is there any short-hand for something like this:

```
Array<int> ints;  
String str = "";
```

... - adds some elements to 'ints'

```
for(int q = -1; ++q < ints.GetCount(); ) {  
    str += AsString(ints[q]) + " ";  
}
```

?

excluding

```
for(int q = -1; ++q < ints.GetCount(); str += AsString(ints[q]) + " ");
```

Well, not much better, but

```
for(int q = 0; q < ints.GetCount(); i++) // you can keep your version here too, I like this better...  
    str << ints[q] << ' ';
```

..as operator<< for Stream and String translates to calling AsString...

Not that using "<<" is also faster here (because you are adding to existing string, instead of concating and adding...)
