Above solution still has a flaw.

If the Ctrl (the outmost container) in a page is modified and the containing page is crossed (to initiate a close request), the user will be prompted whether he/she wants to save, discard edit or cancel the close action when overridden `Accept()` is called from within `CancelClose` gate. If user selects "no" to discard change (close without saving) and no action was taken to unset the modified flag, the `Accept()` gets called again before the Ctrl is destructed. A simple fix would be to always reset modified flag when the user chooses to discard edit. This way when `Accept()` is called at the moment of destruction, it always returns true so that it is silently disposed of as wished.
