Yes it is possible. But you have to have the sources - you can check them out from the public mirror, if you don't already have them:svn.exe checkout

Now you have everything necessary and you just have to tell theide where to look. To do this create a new assembly which will point to following

Now you can open uppweb package in this assembly, compile it and run it. It will generate the pages somewhere on your disk (not sure about the default now) and generate uppweb.xml configuration file in your home directory where you can tweak the paths for future runs.
