Wolfgang wrote on Tue, 13 December 2011 10:54I asked my how to make use of more than one .sch file, I mean if I want to use more than 1 sqlite3 database and want to use schema files?

For one it is clear, first I tell which file I want to use

```
#define SCHEMADIALECT <plugin/sqlite3/Sqlite3Schema.h>
```

```
#define MODEL <urlaub/urlaub.sch>
```

and then

```
SqlSchema sch(SQLITE3);
```

```
    All_Tables(sch);
```

```
    SqlPerformScript(sch.Upgrade());
```

```
    SqlPerformScript(sch.Attributes());
```

but I can't see how to specify more than one file for more than one database!

If I understand well where the problem is:

You can specify SqlSession as first SqlPerformScript parameter.

It is true that using more databases is somewhat more difficult, it is recommended to add NOAPPSQL config flag - that kicks out global SQL (and new SQLR), which is usually a source of errors in multodb apps...
