The easiest way is to use virtualization. With some simple, free virtualization tool (e.g. VirtualBox), you can maintain a number of linux distros that you want to support.

Another option might be using cygwin. If I remember correctly there used to be gcc package that compiled linux binaries. Google will surely give you some more info.

I'd definitely recommend you the first way.
