Well, this is something that was sort of omitted in the past, however it seems like it would be worth to support columns names that are in conflict with SQL keywords, like:

```
select FROM from TABLE
```

which can be legally written in SQL as

```
select "FROM" from TABLE
```

Obviously, putting " around all Sqlld names is relatively simple to do, with little complaint that resulting SQL logs will a little bit harder to read.

Then I was thinking about puttin " only around Sqllds that are in conflict.... potentially slow.

Ha! Maybe put it everywhere and then remove all \" from SQL logs? Simple enough.
