It was compiled in Win and worked OK.

Running on Ubuntu with Wine was the problem.

If your code can be pasted into the SDK overwriting the current code I will try it, it may be a few days before I can get to it.

I don't know about that issue, but here is a merge for the hack I'm using for IPV6 clients made with U++ 4552.

I hope that some day I'll have time to do a proper fix and add support for IPv6 servers too .
