'prova4::sum' : illegal call of non-static member function c:\myapps\prova3\prova3.h(28) : see declaration of 'prova4::sum'

Where I'm wrong today ?!

As compiler message said, you need static prova4::sum function to use it this way:

};
```

Else you need to create object instance of prova4 class for using it:

prova4 p; int result = p.sum(1, 2);
