Thanks, mr\_ped. Your preprocessor idea directed me towards a victory against my forgetfulness .  
Btw, your idea had one more side-effect - to discover that theide has got gcc -E built-in! I was aware of gcc -E but never used it. So, the code generated output was big and didn't look suspicious to me. I didn't study it too much. But while exploring I started thinking about \*.h files. And then the lightning struck!.. ... Started thinking about other packages.. XCode objc and..

I added one more \*.h file to the package and included into TEST.mm -eureka!

So, if you have \*.cpp and .mm files in your packages 1(one!) \*.h file is not enough! And mostly \*.mm and \*.h go in pairs.

By accident I have been using that way all the time...

It would be good to understand what is inside the compiler thinking in this case..
