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If I use a dark background theme the colors on a formatted text are ignored. For example a "[@R=Red] [@G = Green] [@B Blue]" will all be showing white instead of Red-Green-Blue.

I found the reason in:

Which basically tells the control to override the all the colors of the text.

Is there a way to tell the control not to clobber the text colors when the background is dark?
