Check this code:

String error; String result = HttpClientGet("someserver.com/somefile.txt", NULL, &error); if(result.IsEmpty()) Cout << "Error: " << error << "\n";

Runs OK on windows, but prints this error in linux:

Error: socket(3) / connect(someserver.com:80): Operation now in progress

HttpClientGet is supposed to download the file during the call, and not return until ready or timeout, correct?
