Check this code:

```
String error;
```

```
String result = HttpClientGet("someserver.com/somefile.txt", NULL, &error);
```

```
if(result.IsEmpty())
```

```
    Cout << "Error: " << error << "\n";
```

Runs OK on windows, but prints this error in linux:

Error: socket(3) / connect(someserver.com:80): Operation now in progress
