In some toolkit I can write like:

```
TABLE_(WORKER) PREFIX(wrk)
  INT_ (ID) PRIMARY_KEY
  STRING_ (NAME, 200)
  STRING_ (LASTNAME, 200)
  INT_ (PLANT_ID)
END_TABLE
```

```
TABLE_(PLANT) PREFIX(pla)
  INT_ (ID) PRIMARY_KEY
  STRING_ (NAME, 200)
  STRING_ (ADDRESS, 200)
END_TABLE
```

And then I can use simple `pla.NAME` and `wrk.NAME` (or `pla::NAME` and `wrk::NAME`, or `pla_NAME` and `wrk_NAME`).

Now I must do like:

```
TABLE_(WORKER)
  INT_ (wrk_ID) PRIMARY_KEY
  STRING_ (wrk_NAME, 200)
  STRING_ (wrk_LASTNAME, 200)
  INT_ (wrk_PLANT_ID)
END_TABLE
```

```
TABLE_(PLANT) PREFIX(pla)
  INT_ (pla_ID) PRIMARY_KEY
  STRING_ (pla_NAME, 200)
  STRING_ (pla_ADDRESS, 200)
END_TABLE
```
