Hello,

i am trying to use the Skylark to do something like the following

```
class WebServer : public SkylarkApp {
public:
    void StopServer();
    void StartServer();

};

class SimpleGUI : public TopWindow , public WebServer {
public:
    SimpleGUI() {
        StartServer();
    }

    virtual ~SimpleGUI() {
        StopServer();
    }
}
```

GUI operation for desktop user, and web operation for smart phone user.

so i try to modify the code, like

```
class WebServer : public SkylarkApp {
public:
    WebServer() {
        Run();
    }
    virtual ~WebServer(){
    }

    void StopServer() {
        TheApp().quit = true;

        TcpSocket h;
        h.Connect("127.0.0.1", TheApp().port);
        h.Put("quit");
    }
}
```

}  
void StartServer() {  
    for( int i=0; i<threads; ++i ) {  
        Thread::Start( THISBACK(ThreadRun) );  
    }  
}  
  
virtual void Main() {  
  
}  
  
};
```

and it didn't work apparently,
