Hi,

I am using Backtrack 5 R1 (should be like Ubuntu), 32Bit with Gnome. The current user is root. I tried to install TheIDE from the Debian Package File 'theide_4194-2~precise0_i386.deb'.

For the installation i used the following command:

```
Quote:dpkg -i '/root/Desktop/theide_4194-2~precise0_i386.deb'
```

But i got the following output:
