Thisback take reference to the function, with parameter passed to the function as another parameters to the THISBACK# macro. So it should be called like this:THISBACK(function1)

THISBACK1(function2,123)

THISBACK2(function3,123,"param")

...

I'm not even sure how it could even work for you with the one parameter function. Probably its return type was matching something that THISBACK accepts...

Have a look at the reference and example programs, perhaps also reading and trying out the tutorial and figure out how ts might help. I understand that some poeple (me included) prefer to just play with the toolkit and figure out how it works by themselves, but U++ contains so many unusual concepts and has quite steep learning curve, so following the tutorial and reading the manuals can help (and save you some frustration).
