THISBACK2(function3,123,"param")

..

I'm not even sure how it could even work for you with the one parameter function Probably its return type was matching something that THISBACK accepts...

Have a look at the reference and example programs, perhaps also reading and trying out the tutorial and figure out how to might help. I understand that some poeple (me included.) prefer to just play with the toolkit and figure out how it works by themselfs, but U++ contains so many unusual concepts and has quite steep learning curve, so following the tutorial and reading the manuals can help (and save you some frustration.).
