In 2010 I tinkered with FrameLess and did not have the clipping problem.

There were two problems then. On the task bar it didn't work correctly which seems OK now. It was not drag able with out the top.

I will just have something like Ctrl+M+arrow keys.

For different computers the location is slightly different.

Clicking a Save>Exit option and:

```
leftP = GetRect().left;
topP = GetRect().top;
String LeftP = Format("%.0f", leftP);
String TopP = Format("%.0f", topP);
```

the location is saved to a .cfg file (along with a dozen other parameters) and only needs to be done once on each computer.

So now it is just a problem with the clipping.

On another computer the right is clipped so much it creates another menu bar and the bottom 2 EditField lines are gone.

It should be like this without the top bar:
