Hi Matteo,

This error should mean that there is a character in the file that (gcc thinks) is not supposed to be there. The three numbers are its octal representation of the offending character. Since they are all rather high numbers, those are probably some non-ascii characters. Check the files at given lines and positions to see what is there. Note, that sometimes those characters might be non-printable in current charset, so it might be hard to spot them. Hexaeditor can help in such case.
