ArrayCtrl has three overload of the Ctrls method, one of thems is described in the reference manual as:

The methods sets up a factory which the ArrayCtrl uses as necessary to create new Ctrl's for editing a given column. The argument of this function is a callback, which, upon execution, should allocate (normally using the new operator) the desired editor object and set it to its argument. If the position of Ctrl is equivalent to 'SetRect(0, 0, 0, 0)', which is the default value, Ctrl is resized to fit the ArrayCtrl cell accurately, otherwise the position represents the position within the cell. factory callback used for new control creation Return value \*this

you can edit a cell by: myArray.Set(row, col, value);
