Hi,

I've downloaded the latest Nvidia CUDA SDK with the intention of updating the OpenCL.lib and the like; I've tested it with a simple application but it does not work. I can not tune TheIDE to access the correct library folders,etc..Any hint about how to tune the package organaizer to allow OpenCL to work?

What I'm doing is:

1.- I'm currently using OpenCL 1.1 version with the cl.hpp file for C++. All files can be downloaded together with the Nvidia SDK except the cl.hpp, which I downloaded from the Khronos web site (this file is not included in the new version of the SDK, to my surprise).

2.- I am running a simple OpenCL application that works (it worked with the 2010 version of the Nvidia SDK); the application compiles but the linking process fails.

Any advice?
