Hello,

when I build my application under Ubuntu (BLITZ + Shared libs) the IDE automatically use libstdc++6 although I've also libstdc++5. Some users using Suse and libstdc++5 report to be not able to run the program. They suggested me to link against the old libstdc++5 to increase the portability. How to do it? (Please consider that Blitz + All static option doesn't work and the only build method that works is only BLITZ + Shared libs).
