When I want to upload a file to share-online.biz, i cant pass the filename as an parameter.

The second request doesn't work because there is no filename parameter. How can I pass the filename without a filename parameter?

I guess it's really service specific, anyway I would dare to say that an alternative to passing filename parameter would be "RESTful" - pass it as part of url. Perhaps something like
