Or can I change the rendering code? Where can I find this line breaking logic in U++ code? You could find "line breaking logic" for U++ RichText inside of RichPara::FormatLines method. To allow line breaks for '-' character, it is possible to change (for your local copy of RichText package) following line of code:

```
if(*s == ' ') {
```

to:

```
if(*s == ' ' || *s == '-') {
```
