I'm trying to make a debian package for my app.

As the guideline instructs, the code must be in a directory named as appname-version. So it would look like test-1.0

but when i put my code under such a dir, and try

```
umk ../usr/share/upp/uppsrc test GCC ...
```

it cannot find my code. Then I changed "test" in the above line to test-1.0, and it needs test-1.upp.

After I copied my test.upp to test-1.upp, it just finished building, successfully, but without actually doing anything.

first, it would be better to separate dirname and upp file name.

second, please take dot as a normal part of a name.
