I think that antivirus producers should be sued because of this. They made me lose a couple of customers with their dumb behaviour.

I read up a bit on the topic, and the conclusion is that if you sign the executable (after crypting it) with a valid code certificate then the number of false positives will greatly reduce.
The Microsoft signtool is already included with the compiler.
The certificate costs about 180 euros a year.
