SqlArray table;

table.AddCtrl(COLUMNID, myctrl);

I have the SqlArray named "CListView" on a TabCtrl named "tab" with a tab named "list". I used the designer to add a StringEdit called "strName1" to the list layout.

list.CListView.AddCtrl("NAME",list.strName1);

I eventually want to move the controls to a different tab, but I have them here for testing. When I navigate to different rows, it does look like the control might be refreshing, but there is nothing there. It will save data to the database, but not show it.
