I do not want GTK, how do I compile this package using the nogtk-flag?

Hi slashupp,

I'm afraid that is not really possible with the pregenerated makefile

But if you wish, you can grab a copy of the universal makefile and run it like this:cd

upp-x11-src-6715

make -f /path/to/mkfile PKG=ide FLAGS=".NOGTK GUI GCC"

That should do the trick. It also works for most other packages. More details about the usage can  
be found in the makefile itself.
