What do you mean? This command would install TheIDE, and nothing else. That might be what you want, e.g. in case when you use U++ sources from svn. But many people prefer to use U++ sources from the upp package. The upp package depends on theide package, so the command Neil posted above actually installs both TheIDE and U++ sources.

Also, the last step ("click on `/usr/share/upp/uppsrc/ide/TheIDE`") could be replaced by "find TheIDE in your applications menu" in most desktop environments
