Hi Koldo,

yes, this works, too.

But I think we can leave out the extern "C" { ... } declarations since __cdecl already instructs the compiler to use C calling conventions (see http://msdn.microsoft.com/en-us/library/zkwh89ks%28v=vs.80%2 9.aspx).

So the following would be enough to include at the top of parser.cpp or even in Core.h:

```
#if defined(COMPILER_MINGW)
_CRTIMP unsigned int __cdecl __MINGW_NOTHROW _clearfp(void);
#define SW_OVERFLOW 0x00000004
#endif
```

It even builds correctly without __cdecl under my configuration.
