if you serialize a structure that contains multiline text in Linux and try to read it in Windows then you get an error (and vice versa). I think this is because of the additional carriage return of text lines in Windows.

This CR you have to take care of as well when reading text files in a string and split it into lines.

I think there should be an option to strip this CR. Isn't it?
