Hello !

I did a svn checkout of u++ and what I've got is a kind of mess, how is this organized ? Why there is several folders with duplicated code ?

It ends up without any makefile or script to build.

I tried to search "repository" on this forum but it doesn't bring up any answer for this question.

Hello mingodad, and welcome to U++ forums!

If you want to use svn, I'd recommend checking out only the required directory to build U++ apps, which is <http://upp-mirror.googlecode.com/svn/trunk/uppsrc> (always contains the latest version) (For example I usually download .../trunk/uppsrc, .../trunk/bazaar, .../trunk/reference directories, but only the uppsrc is mandatory).

If you use windows, just download the installer package and then checkout the directories to your preference

If you use linux, just use your distro's package manager, and install the subversion client; after your first checkout you will be able to update it from TheIDE.
