Since manjaro is based on archlinux, you can try to use the packages for arch. It should be enough to just add this to your /etc/pacman.conf:

U++ nightly builds

[home_dolik_rce_nightly_Arch_Extra_standard]

SigLevel=Never

Server=http://download.opensuse.org/repositories/home:/dolik_rce:/nightly/Arch_Extra_standard/\$ arch/

Then you should be able to install it usingsudo pacman -S theide upp

Note that I have never tested the packages on manjaro, but on arch, they work just fine...
