Hi Mirek,

I'm using \$ and I like it :) There is 352 dollar signs in Watchdog and none of them needed to be escaped. However, I don't use (and don't like :)) jquery. I understand that others might be in different situation.

The # and @ characters can have their own problems - # is used in CSS, and @ can be present in javascript code handling emails or tweets... It would probably be less problematic than jquery, but still possibly problematic.

I'd like to suggest to make it configurable, it should be pretty easy. Skylark can be used to do much more than serving html web pages. Having the code designation configurable would make it possible for the programmer to choose what fits his scenario best.
