How do I

change it to invoke the Intel compiler instead of the Microsoft compiler?

In "Setup" menu, there is option "Be verbose" which causes every executed command (and it's output) to be displayed. To specify exact compiler to use, there is a field "Compiler name" in the "Build methods" dialog. I believe you can put there full path to the compiler.

I must confess that I have heard about the Intel Composer XE. Does it use the icc for compiling or something else? I have never tried, but icc seems to be compatible with Visual C++, so it might actually work in the IDE without much hassle... However if it does not use icc, then I must warn you that getting the IDE to fully support new compiler might be rather more work.
