Quote:

I have setup an assembly for using the "latest" files. And both the apps I am working on now do compile and seem to run ok.

Why is there a difference between uppsrc and uppsrc.uvs? Does that mean my local copy is not correctly up to sync- or something else?

Also, I notice some of the same files are in uppbbox as uppsrc. Are these the same file on your computer, just referenced in two different places?

uppsrc.uvs is "local repository", to be used by uvs2 only. It is a black-box used by uvs2. Do not touch files there directly.

BTW, that is one of uvs2 features I would/will miss with normal versioning system - you can always launch uvs2 and review file history without connecting to the server (because all history is stored in local repository).

As for same files, which one are you speaking about (give me example as there are more explanations).
