Edward wrote on Sat, 28 February 2015 06:52I was curious why some project folders, in my MyApps folder, were not listed in the opening U++ Select Main Package form, while others were listed.

This is a very common practice in IDEs.

Hi Edward,

By default, TheIDE only shows "Main packages". Main package means that it has main package configuration (set via corresponding dialg from Project menu) and it usually contains main()/CONSOLE\_APP\_MAIN/GUI\_APP\_MAIN method.

Check the select box in lower left corner of the dialog, it allows you to display non-main packages as well and also packages from other nests in the same assembly.
