Hi,

Not having GetDPIForMonitor() does not seem to be a catastrophe. I tried a few things on Windows 8.1 with two displays (UHD as primary and FullHD as secondary):

It seems we can always query "Windows main display's" DPI using  
GetDeviceCaps(handle,LOGPIXELSX) and GetDeviceCaps(handle,LOGPIXELSY).

If the window is moved to another display, a WM\_DPICHANGED message is received with  
wParam LOWORD and HIWORD reporting the new DPI values of the monitor, the window was  
moved to.

If the initial display DPI is read at window creation time with GetDeviceCaps() and always updated  
when a WM\_DPICHANGED message is received, I think we have it all covered.
