        Set_t1("2 OK");  
}
```

Set_t1 is not defined. And the function should return something. Anyway, after comment the Set_t1 thing and return an empty String, and change your GUI_MAIN to something like

```
GUI_APP_MAIN {  
    H1 h;  
    h.Open();  
    h.TopMost().Run();  
}
```
